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




Every seventh person says they are interested in what is happening internationally with every fifth following closely the events.




Q. To what extent are you personally interested in events taking place internationally (in other countries)?

The international uncertain context is affecting Moldovan citizens as well.




Q. Please tell me, are you personally worried or not worried about the political changes taking place internationally?

62.1% of citizens believe that Moldova is linked to the international events. Yet, the influence is seen differently by different groups. For e.g. only 42% say that the change in the US position towards the EU and Ukraine will have for the Republic of Moldova negative effect.




Q. To what extent do you think the socio-political and economic life in the Republic of Moldova is influenced by the events taking place internationally?


The international context divides opinions about the peace negotiations in favour of Ukraine: now it's more about emotions than facts.

ReArm versus Protections: 60% support Moldova's consolidation of its army. The new context is making Moldovans aware of their week points.






Q. Do you think it is necessary to create a common army of the European Union, in the current security context?

Q. Do you think that Moldova needs to strengthen its national army, based on the current events taking place internationally?




The weak points of a small state might become opportunities in communication to achieve foreign policy aims.




Q. Do you believe Moldova can develop on its own without external help (from the EU, other states?)

Six months after the Referendum – no change in the support towards the country's EU accession. Yes- 63% support, less are ready to actively show their support.




Q: Do you personally support or oppose the Republic of Moldova's integration into the EU?

The Referendum Campaigns had not influence people's choice.





Majority can shape mindsets of minority – yet the referendum did not significantly contribute to achieving this goal.




Q: In your opinion, does the majority of Moldova's population currently support the country joining the EU?

- Context, timing and format of the message matters.
- Link your messages to international actors and events to strengthen your points.
- ➤ How do you frame your message matters: the EU will make us economically better versus EU it is the best options that we have.
- ➤ If you will not talk about it, someone else will Traditional Values.
- > Build your message on something that is already there instead of trying to bring something entirely new.
- ➤ Shifting mindsets it is a long-term deal 6 months are enough to test you approach not to change the world.
- ➤ Together we are stronger BUT coordinated campaigns instead of doing all of us the same.


